

BASIC RULES FOR PETS IN THE FACILITY

This information sheet summarises some simple rules that you must observe in order to enjoy the experience of our Family Camping Villages in complete safety and relaxation.

This facility only accepts pets that:

- Are at least 4 months old;
- Have been regularly vaccinated, as proven by the vaccination booklet, which must be carried with them always;
- Have a health certificate issued by a veterinarian certifying that they have been treated for parasites (internal and external parasites) for less than 21 days prior to entering the Facility;
- Dogs must be properly registered with the dog register and must not be entered in the competent bite register;
- Cats must have a negative FiV FeIV test, which can be proved by appropriate certification;
- Have liability insurance cover for damage caused by the animal or have personal insurance to cover any damage caused by the pet.

RULES OF CONDUCT

- 1. The person in charge of the animal is obliged to use, at all times and in all places with the exception of designated exercise areas a leash no longer than 1.50 m in length;
- 2. Carry a muzzle (hard or soft) at all times in case of potential danger;
- 3. Animals are not allowed inside the toilet facilities, in the swimming pool, in the market, or in the children's layground;
- 4. In the facility, it is obligatory to pick up animal excrement and to dispose of it in accordance with proper waste disposal;
- 5. Animals may never be left unattended and free to roam, and the owner/handler is therefore civilly and criminally liable for damage or injury to persons, animals or property caused by their pet;
- 6. Your pet is welcome in the restaurant, and it is very important to make a reservation to allow you the best space in terms of comfort and safety.

SWIMMING

For dogs to enter the water at the Bau Beach, the by-laws of the location of the facility must be followed.

SANCTIONS

Failure to comply with the regulations listed above will lead to the application of a penalty from \leq 50 to \leq 250, in addition to the Management's right to expel the guest from the Facility.

Any ill-treatment of animals will be reported to the competent authorities.

To guarantee all guests a peaceful stay and peaceful coexistence, the Management reserves the right to expel anyone who does not comply with the Rules and Regulations.
